### Some figures in Dutch healthcare

- Population: 16,000,000
- general practitioners: 7,000
- medical specialists: 16,000
- prescriptions per year (via pharmacies): 120,000,000
- pharmacies: 1,600
- hospitals: 100
- healthcare insurance companies: 80
- clearing house pharmacy: 1
- pharmaceutical statistics institutes: 4



#### **General Practitioner**

- Process:
  - diagnosis
  - prescribing
- tools:
  - GP information system
  - electronic prescription support system
  - drug database
  - prescription message





- Process:
  - medication surveillance
  - dispensing
- tools:
  - pharmacy information system
  - drug database
  - prescription message (from GP)
  - dispensing report message (to GP)
  - web site





- Process: deputy service
- tool: medication retrieval message (to pharmacy)
- Process: hospitalisation of patient
- tool: medication report message (to hospital)
- Process: reimbursement, management
- tools: reimbursement file to insurance company
  - data file to statistics institute



# **Electronic prescription support** system

- Project 1999-2003
- goals: improved quality, reduced costs
- Guidelines of NHG (Dutch College of General Practitioners)
- ICPC-diagnosis (International Code of Primary Care)
- sex, age, relevant contraindications
- integrated in GP information system and drug database
- digital formulary



#### **Prescription message**

- Edifact message MEDREC (1989)
- Dutch national standard
- all GP information systems can send prescription
- some GP IS accept dispensing report message
- used in 5% of potential number
- 25% of GP's is directly connected to pharmacy
- >30% prescriptions via fax

## Prescription message, demands of healthcare inspectorate

KMMP

- Freedom of choice for the patient
- unambiguous
- clear procedures
- security and privacy
- authorisation and verification
- archive
- responsibility
- fax does not comply with the law



## Prescription message, developments

- Implementation of new version of MEDREC
- coded instructions for use
- CEN ENV 13607 is basis for new standard
- identification of patients and healthcare person
- network, internet



## Medication retrieval and report message

- Deputy service of one pharmacy for a group of pharmacies (evening and weekend)
- identify a patient in deputy pharmacy
- find the information of that patient with cross reference index on a LDAP-server in closed pharmacy
- information system in closed pharmacy sends a medication report message (6 months history)
- deputy pharmacy sends dispensing report message to closed pharmacy



#### Drug database G-Standaard

- Z-Index, a company of KNMP, maintains G-Standaard
- de facto standard used by entire healthcare sector
- drugs, medical supplies, OTC, homeopathic products
- 80,000 product packages
- package number, aggregated numbers
- updated data files every month
- data files are source for information systems of GP,
   pharmacy, insurance company, scientific institutes, .....

#### G-Standaard, functionalities

- Medication surveillance: dosage, interaction, contraindication, double medication (with advice text)
- dispensing: substitution, label texts, ingredients for compound products
- reimbursement: clustering, prices, price limits, declaration data
- logistics: barcodes stock control, ordering, responsible producer, wholesaler
- statistics: ATC, DDD



#### Reimbursement

- Declaration from pharmacy to insurance company
- largely via clearing house
- reimbursement files every month
- national standard
- one record per dispensed medicine

#### **Statistics**



- Foundation for Pharmaceutical Statistics (SFK)
- within the office of KNMP
- panel of 1360 out of 1630 pharmacies
- data files every month
- one record per medicine
- drug, pharmacy, prescriber, patient, insurance
- data warehouse, web based reports, Facts & figures

- portal web site for all Dutch pharmacies
- information > 200 drugs (active ingredient)
- > 700 pharmacies have their own web site
